

JINDABYNE EXECUTIVE PET-FRIENDLY AGREEMENT

Jindabyne Executive, 15b Twynam St Jindabyne, is pet friendly, and we are happy to welcome your pet. Though there are some extra Terms & Conditions to keeping your animal on the property.

If you intend to bring a pet, you must notify Jindabyne Executive with a description of your pet and receive approval, and pay the pet fee, before arrival. If you have not received approval your pet is prohibited from entering the property.

If your pet enters our property you hereby agree to the following:

1. Your pet is a domesticated dog and is not a dangerous breed.
2. Your pet is fully house trained.
3. No more than 2 pets are permitted.
4. To pay a non-refundable fee for my pet of \$120 per pet per stay. You understand that additional fees may apply in the event your pet causes any damage. Please click here to make your pet payment, before your arrival.

5. To pay the property any charges for any necessary cleaning or repairs due to pet stains and/or damage as determined within sole discretion of the property. You hereby agree for your credit card on file to be charged for the cost of these additional services and/or deduction from your bond.
6. Remove and dispose of any litter or waste, associated with my pet, in the outside red garbage bins.
7. You are responsible for any noise your pet creates and will ensure that your pet does not bark extensively or disrupt the quiet enjoyment of the neighbours.
8. Should the property determine, in its sole discretion, that your pet is objectionable to others, you must immediately make other arrangements to house the pet off the premises. If you cannot make other arrangements for your pet, your booking will be cancelled, with immediate eviction and no refunds.
9. You confirm that your pet does not have any communicable illness or diseases and is up to date with flea and tick treatment.
10. All pets must be kept off all bedding and furniture at all times.
11. Temperatures in Jindabyne during the winter can easily drop to below freezing during the day, therefore you cannot leave your pet outside all day between the months of July to September.
12. You also cannot leave your pet inside alone all day, unless you have a small dog that can use the pet door, which allows them to go outside to relieve themselves. If so, then all bedroom doors must be closed whilst you are out. This is only for small breeds. Otherwise, you will need to designate for someone to remain with the pet during the day.
